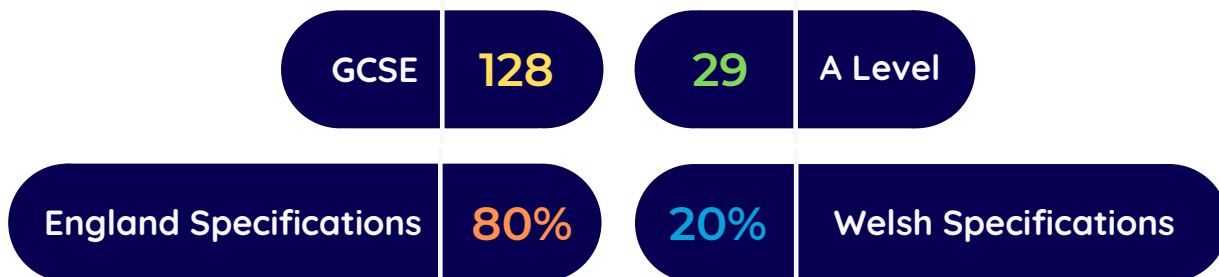

Tute courses are used by schools, alternative providers, home educators and for students without alternative provision.

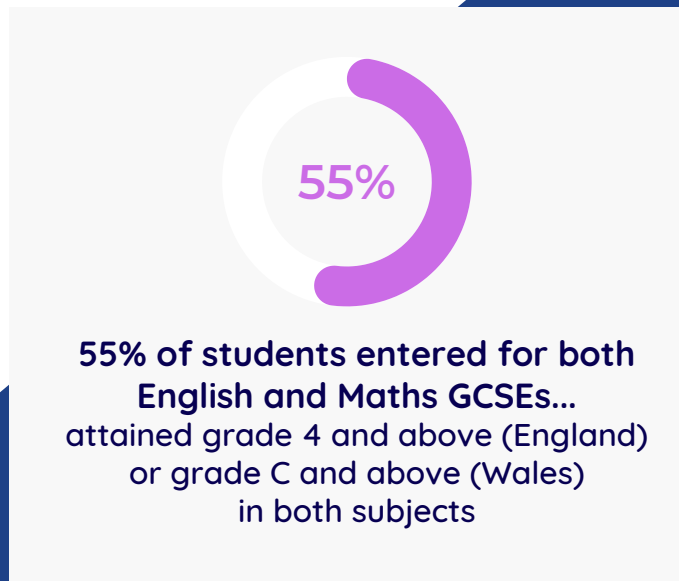
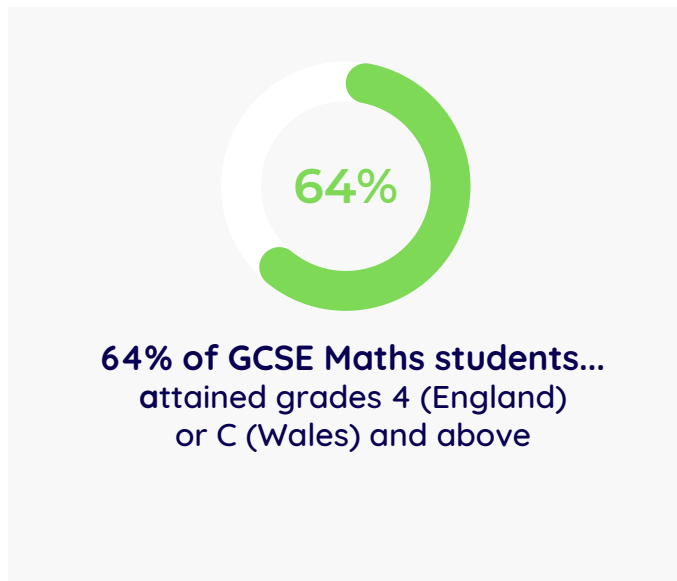
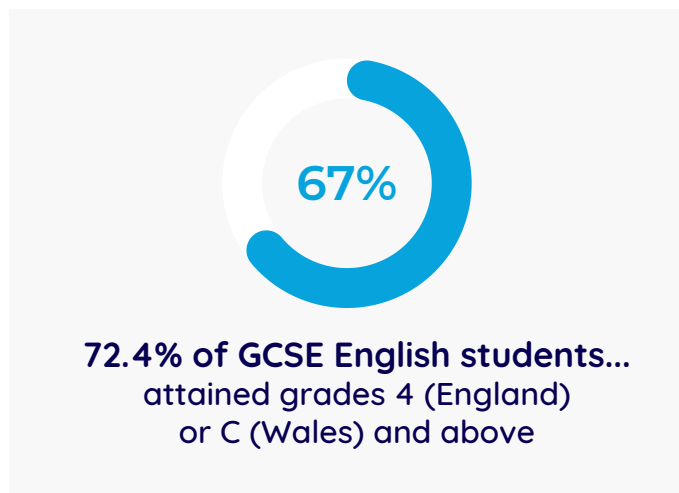
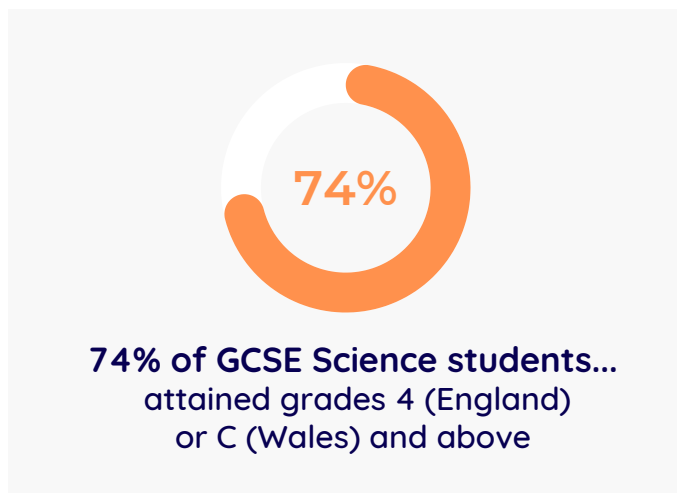
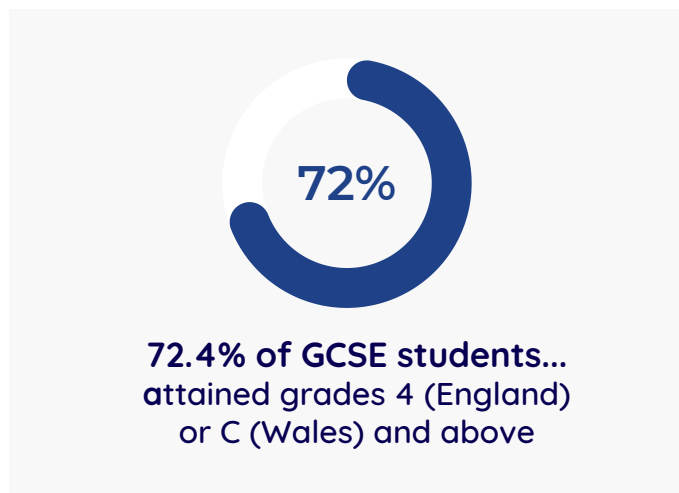
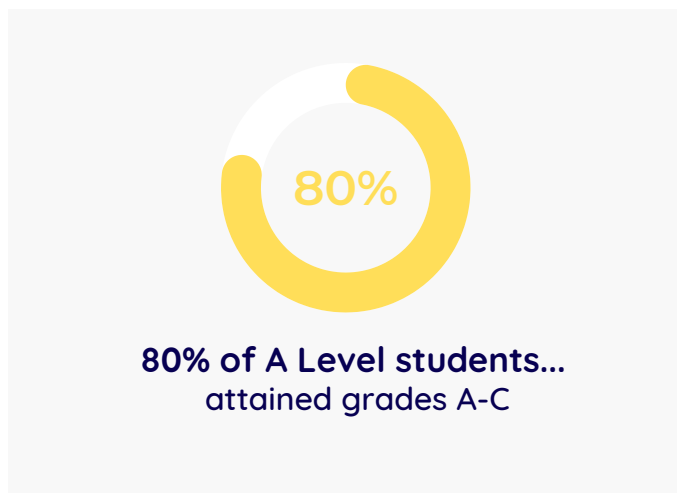
Students often join our courses having previously had barriers to their education, they may have been out of mainstream education for a considerable amount of time or may need to complete their courses in a condensed time period.
