

# ESOL: PRE-ENTRY LEVEL

The Pre-Entry Summer School will enable new learners to access the most basic level of English in preparation for starting school or college in September.

Students will learn the shapes and sounds of the alphabet through a systematic, phonics-based approach.

They will simultaneously study a large set of everyday vocabulary and basic functional language enabling them to express feelings, colours, clothes and greetings.
